CAREER & COLLEGE PROMISE - COLLEGE TRANSFER PATHWAYS – NURSING TRANSFER (P1032C)

Career and College Promise College offers four Transfer Pathways: the Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Engineering and the Nursing Transfer Pathway. Transfer Pathways are designed for high school juniors and seniors who plan to obtain a four-year baccalaureate degree.

The general education courses below fulfill Box 1 of the RN to BSN Uniform Articulation Agreement between the University of North Carolina RN to BSN Programs and the NC Community College Associate Degree Nursing Programs. Constituent institutions of the UNC System offering the RN to BSN program include: Appalachian State, East Carolina, Fayetteville State, NC Agricultural and Technical University, NC Central, UNC-Charlotte, UNC-Greensboro, UNC-Pembroke, UNC-Wilmington, Western Carolina and Winston-Salem State.

Career and College Promise students may enroll in one of the four College Transfer Pathways and may register only for the classes listed in their pathway. No course substitutions are allowed. Changing from one pathway to another is permitted with prior written approval from the high school Principal/Home School Administrator and the College. Students will need to submit a new application indicating the change.

Instructions for students: Below is the list of the classes for your pathway. To locate the online curriculum course schedule, go to the Blue Ridge website at www.blueridge.edu Click “Academics” from the top menu, then “Course Schedule” from the blue menu on the right.

Compare the courses below with those on the schedule. Because classes are offered at various times, each course has a unique “Section Number.” The Section Number lets the Advisor know whether you want a morning, afternoon, evening, or online class. To register for class, complete the upper part of this form, check off the class(es) that you would like to take, list the Section Number in the space provided, and return to me. You may also send me an email listing the courses you would like to take. Please remember to include the section number. I cannot register students without the section number.

Students must earn a grade of “C” or better for courses to transfer. **Tuition is free; however, students are responsible for fees, supplies, and textbooks.**
