PLACEMENT TESTING

Do you need Placement Testing?

Students who meet multiple measures, have SAT/ACT scores that meet requirements, or have obtained a bachelor's degree or higher may not need placement testing. Contact Admissions at **828.694.1800** to determine if you meet the above exemptions for testing.
