



Adult High School Program (AHS)

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the AHS Program?

The AHS program is a partnership between Blue Ridge Community College and Henderson and Transylvania County Public Schools. The program allows you to complete your high school coursework through our Adult Education department and obtain an Adult High School Diploma.

How much do the classes cost? The classes are free.

Where are classes offered?

Classes are offered at both the Transylvania County Campus in Brevard and the Henderson County Campus in Flat Rock.

When are the classes offered?

Classes are offered through a web-based program, though students are required to come to campus at least 6 hours each week to work in the Adult High School Lab. Students are encouraged to work outside of the required on campus hours either at home or in the College & Career Readiness Lab.

How long do the classes run?

Classes run continuously throughout the year. Our attendance policy is a minimum of 6 hours per week. Students may need to work above the minimum weekly hours depending on their personal goals. The more time you put into completing your courses, the faster you will complete them!

What are the requirements for entering the program?

You must obtain a copy of your high school transcript. If you are under the age of 18, you must have a signed affidavit. Once you have these documents, you may sign up for orientation. At orientation, you take an assessment. Students entering the AHS program must score an Intermediate High level on the assessment to be eligible for the AHS program. If you score below the Intermediate High Level, we will work with you to bring up your score. Once you reach the Intermediate High Level, you can enter into the AHS program.

When is orientation offered?

The orientation schedule depends on the semester. Once we receive your application and transcript, we will contact you with available dates.

How do I get verification I am attending class?

You may request a verification letter after attending a minimum of 40 hours of class. Please allow 7-10 business days from the date of your request.
