Set-Up and Access myBlueRidge



One of the most important steps to becoming a student is setting up your myBlueRidge account.

myBlueRidge, located at my.blueridge.edu, allows you to contact your academic advisor, create a course plan, register for courses, check your financial aid status, make payments, view your grades, access an unofficial

transcript, and much more. Follow these easy steps to get started:

- Using Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox, visit blueridge.edu and click on the blue “Students” button at the top right-hand side of the home page.
- Choose “WebAdvisor” and from the WebAdvisor homepage, click “I’m New to BRCC” at the bottom right.
- Follow the four steps to retrieve your username and temporary password to complete the set-up.
- Finish the log-in process by creating your own unique password. Now that you have your username and unique password, you may log-in to myBlueRidge, your student Webmail account, and myCourses.

Paying for College

Apply for financial aid as early as possible. Applications for federal and state financial aid may be submitted through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov. Placement Testing

Do you need Placement Testing? If you meet RISE requirements, have acceptable SAT/ACT scores, or have obtained an associate degree or higher, you may not need placement testing. Contact Student Services at 828.694.1800 to determine if you meet the above exemptions for testing.

Orientation

New Student Orientation at Blue Ridge is designed to help you become familiar with the college environment and have a successful start to your college career.
