

Exhibit 4 CARES Act Awarding Criteria

Spring 2020

Students attending at least one face-to-face class during Spring 2020 semester, when the state of emergency due to coronavirus was declared (i.e. March 13, 2020), and did not graduate in May 2020. The student must have filed a FAFSA and have been deemed Title IV eligible. Awards will be made on a tiered scale using their Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and the number of credit hours in seated or hybrid (S/H) classes as follows:

Summer 2020

Students attending at least one face-to-face class during Spring 2020 semester, when the state of emergency due to coronavirus was declared (i.e. March 13, 2020), and did not graduate in May 2020. The student must have filed a FAFSA and have been deemed Title IV eligible. Awards will be made on a tiered scale using their Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and the number of credit hours the originally registered for summer that were seated or hybrid (S/H) classes as follows:

0	\$1,250	\$1,000	\$750	\$500

Fall 2020

Students attending at least one face-to-face class during Spring 2020 semester, when the state of emergency due to coronavirus was declared (i.e. March 13, 2020), and did not graduate in May 2020. The student must have filed a FAFSA and have been deemed Title IV eligible. Awards will be made on a tiered scale to enrolled students using their Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and the number of WE or IE grades in 2021SP classes as follows:
