Students may take the ATI TEAS exam twice within one admissions year (October 1, 2021 – February 1, 2022). Students will have to pay for both testing sessions. **To retest, see Julie Brackett or Laura Simmons in the Sink Building on the Flat Rock Campus.**Retesting can be done during any scheduled test session, if space is available.

Students must "Create an Account" at <a href="www.atitesting.com">www.atitesting.com</a>, before arriving to take the exam. During the process of creating an account, you will be asked to select an Institution. Please select "Blue Ridge CC NC TEAS".



- Do not register or sign up for the test at the ATI site, follow the directions on the front of this ticket.
- Students must bring photo ID, testing ticket, receipt and ATI username and password to testing session.
- Students requiring accommodations for documented disabilities should meet with Angie Uhl-Kalev, Director of Disability Services at 828-694-1813, at least two weeks prior to scheduled exam.
- Examinees are not allowed to bring any additional materials with them to use during testing. Scratch paper and pencils will be provided by the Proctor. All scratch paper will be collected following the completion of the exam.
- The exam has a built-in calculator, if a question is deemed to need a calculator, the program will allow for the built-in calculator icon to appear, otherwise the calculator will not appear.
- Cell phones and all other electronic devices are strictly prohibited during the testing sessions. Electronic devices cannot be visible, turned on or used during the testing session. Turn OFF all electronic devices. Cell phones MUST be stored away from the testing area. If a student must leave the exam area for a restroom break, they are not allowed to take their cell phone or personal items out of the room.
- Children are not allowed.
- It is highly recommended that students prepare for the ATI TEAS by using TEAS study manuals or guides of their choosing and/or seeking assistance with Reading, Mathematics, Science and English in the Student Success Center. ATI TEAS Study Guides are available in the Bookstore and are on reserve in the Library.

## Format of the Exam and How the Exam is scored

- The ATI TEAS contains only multiple-choice questions.
- Scrambled versions of the assessments are used to ensure test security.
- There is no penalty for guessing. Any question that is not answered will be scored as incorrect.
- Examinees cannot ask the Proctor questions about the content of the assessment or questions about items on the assessment.

Minimum scores must be obtained for both the RIBN program and the BRCC Associate Degree Nursing. **RIBN requires TEAS with a minimum score of 70** and the **BRCC Associate Degree Nursing requires a score of 67** on the ATI TEAS exam. TEAS scores from TEAS version V(5) will only be accepted for the BRCC Associate Degree Nursing program (RIBN requires TEAS V(6) or ATI TEAS), as long as the score is not more than 3 years old.
