



TR- Traditional 16-week (10-week in summer) Fully Seated Sections with no online component

(Used in very rare cases)

- 001-009 for Henderson County Campus (HCC) day classes, regular 16 week semester schedule
- 011-019 for Henderson County Campus (HCC) evening classes, regular 16-week semester schedule
- 021-029 for Transylvania County Campus (TCC) day classes, regular 16-week semester schedule
- 031-039 for Transylvania County Campus (TCC) evening classes, regular 16-week semester schedule

ITV (NC Information Highway) Seated Sections – Concurrent on 2 or more campuses at once

- *Now using a “V” to indicate the ITV sections, see quick list at bottom of document*

IN- Fully Online Sections

- 201-209 – If there is more than one section of same course: 202, 203, etc.
- 211 – Fully online (with mandatory synchronous meeting days and times)
 - *Students are required to “meet” with their instructor and fellow students online via teleconferencing applications, connect during specified days and times, as well as work independently online for the remainder of the contact hours of the course.*
 - *Students must have a laptop/desktop computer, high internet connection, and web camera to be in these courses.*

HY- Hybrid Sections (50% or more online; rest of course seated)

- 301-309 for full semester Henderson County Campus day classes
- 311-319 for full semester Henderson County Campus evening classes
- 321-329 for full semester Transylvania County Campus day classes
- 331-339 for full semester Transylvania County Campus evening classes

BL -Blended Sections (1%-49.99% online; rest of course seated)

- 701-709 for full semester Henderson County Campus day classes
- 711-719 for full semester Henderson County Campus evening classes
- 721-729 for full semester Transylvania County Campus day classes
- 731-739 for full semester Transylvania County Campus evening classes

HyFLEX- Courses offered with student flexibility (BL or HY: Students have option of FTF or live remote learning*)

- 751-759 for full semester Blended daytime classes offered as HyFlex
- 351-359 for full semester Hybrid daytime classes offered as HyFlex
- 761-769 for full semester Blended evening classes offered as HyFlex
- 361-369 for full semester Hybrid evening classes offered as HyFlex

** The synchronous remote option is at the discretion of the instructor, may be scheduled on an as needed basis*

- 401-409 for HCC day classes
- 411-419 for HCC evening classes
- 421-429 for TCC day classes

Weekend Sections (Hybrid add H; Blended add B)

Off Campus Sections Taught at the High Schools

HSB (Brevard) or HSR (Rosman). – Courses taught at the Transylvania County high schools

HSE (East), HSH (Hendersonville), HSN (North), HSW (West) - Henderson County high schools.

L after the first 3 letters indicates the section is a “Late Start” section. Course begins with the High School calendar dates

Off Campus Sections Taught at Other Community Colleges

FT1, FT2, FT11, FT12 etc. - Day or Eve courses taught at Fayetteville Technical Community College

Addition of L after the first 2-3 letters indicates the section is a “Late Start” section

Addition of H indicates section is a Hybrid; Addition of B indicates section is a Blended.

On Campus Sections for High School Students Only

- E01 or E02 - Classes taught at Henderson County Campus only for Early College students.
- H21, H22 – Classes taught at Transylvania County Campus only for High School students.
- 001C, 301C, 201C – Classes taught at Henderson County Campus only for Career Academy students.

Quick Reference to Alpha-Extensions (Letters added to the beginning or end of section number)

W = Web only/Online Instruction

S = Synchronous Online (when 211 cannot be used)

D = Developmental (Basic Skills Plus)

L = Late Start

C = Career Academy Students

H = Hybrid (50% or more online)

B = Blended (50% or more in person)

SP = Taught in Spanish

E = Early College Students

V = ITV Section (broadcast at both TCC/HCC)
