*\*HyFlex is a multi-modal instructional delivery method where the college has the option to deliver the online portion of a curriculum course synchronously, asynchronously, or both as long as **100% of the instruction is offered face to face** with the instructor in a physical classroom. Students may choose to attend the regularly scheduled in person session or the online option on a session by session basis.*

**Off Campus Sections taught at High Schools (L at the end indicates a late start which coincides with HS dates)**
